**Subject:** Effective Jan. 1, 2022: Medicare Providers Should Submit Claims to Presbyterian for Monoclonal Antibody Treatments and the COVID-19 Vaccine

Dear Provider,

Presbyterian Health Plan, Inc. and Presbyterian Insurance Company, Inc. (Presbyterian) are committed to ensuring providers have the information they need to correctly bill for monoclonal antibody treatments and the COVID-19 vaccine.

Currently, Medicare providers are submitting claims to Original Medicare for monoclonal antibody treatments and the COVID-19 vaccine. Effective for dates of service on or after Jan. 1, 2022, Medicare providers should submit claims to Presbyterian for monoclonal antibody treatments, the COVID-19 vaccine and its administration to Medicare members. Members who receive these services will not incur any cost sharing.
