Northern Roots is a comprehensive produce prescription program that offers families healthy food resources in Northern New Mexico. Program Location: Santa Fe Medical Center and Presbyterian Española Hospital.

Program Components

Providers refer families to the program who can benefit from healthy eating resources in their community!



16-week produce prescription of local fruits, vegetables and pantry items. Patients pick up the food at a hospital food site.



A variety of **hands-on nutrition education** is offered, which includes food demonstrations at the food pick-up site and farmers' markets, cooking classes, and educational



Patients receive tailored support from a Community Health Worker. The CHW provides connections to community resources and programs.

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In the first year, Northern Roots enrolled 163 families and distributed over 1,230 produce bags.



94% of participants said the program increased their ability to provide healthy food to all members of their family.

100% of participants were extremely satisfied with the Northern Roots Program.



Over \$70,000 invested in local food purchasing and infrastructure.
