Each Presbyterian hospital has a unique HEI Facility ID.

Any workforce member participating in online training through our national partners needs to use the appropriate HEI Facility ID to ensure their attendance is recorded and confirmed.

FAQs

Where do I enter my Facility ID?

HEI Facility IDs are required to access online training through the Center for Affiliated Learning (the CAL) and are encouraged when accessing training through the National LGBTQIA+ Health Education Center.

I don't see my hospital on this list. What do I do?

Some of the PHS hospitals don't yet have Facility IDs. Feel free to use the Presbyterian Hospital ID until your site has its own.

I don't see my PMG clinic on this list. What do I do?

Only hospitals have HEI Facility IDs. PMG clinics do not have HEI Facility IDs. Workforce members who work exclusively at PMG locations are encouraged to use the Facility ID of the hospital nearest their work location.
