



Presbyterian Española Hospital Report to the Community 2022

Presbyterian Española Hospital is an acute-care hospital that has been managed by Presbyterian Healthcare Services since 1977. The hospital serves a diverse population of patients from the Española Valley, Rio Arriba County, northern New Mexico, Santa Fe and Los Alamos. Over the years, the hospital has expanded to meet the growing and changing needs of its patients. It offers a wide range of healthcare services, including inpatient care, ambulatory and surgical services, and emergency care, as well as primary and specialty care services. Presbyterian Española Hospital is one of nine hospitals managed by Presbyterian Healthcare Services, which also has a growing multispecialty group.



Our Accomplishments

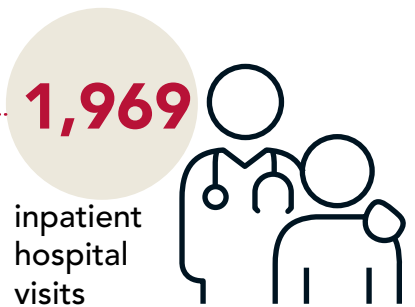
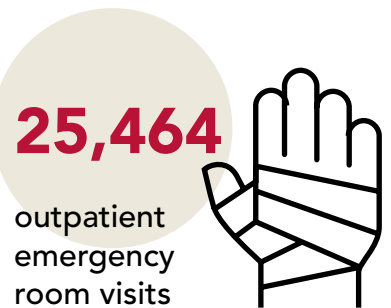
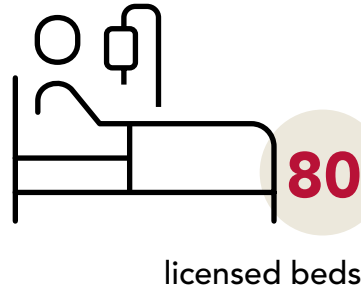
- Our kitchen, which had been closed to the public during the COVID-19 pandemic, reopened to all visitors as well as community members in 2022. Our kitchen provides healthy options, including a fresh salad bar, to patients, staff and visitors.
- We continue to provide meals to the YMCA's Española Teen Center, which provides support, educational opportunities and recreation resources to teens in our community.
- We held a drive-through flu shot clinic in the hospital parking lot in October. We administered free vaccines to 320 community members, 18 years and older.
- We continue to focus on caring for people with substance use disorders. This includes prescribing the life-saving drug Narcan to patients after overdose, offering an Integrated Addiction Medicine Team to assess patients and an opioid use disorder clinic that offers medication-assisted treatment. We also offer peer support to patients who have visited the Emergency Department and need help with alcohol or other substance use.
- We offer Northern Roots, a produce prescription program for patients in need in Española. Northern Roots provides 16 weeks of fresh fruits and vegetables, nutrition education, and connections to food resources and nutrition assistance programs. The program focuses on pregnant women and families with children referred by their health care provider or a community health worker.

Serving Our Community in 2022

- We employed 362 people.
- We provided more than \$48.9 million in employee salaries, wages and benefits.
- We provided more than \$12.7 million in community benefit (including financial assistance).
- We offer the community a diabetes resource center and an infusion center, allowing us to provide outpatient infusion therapy and subcutaneous treatment locally so patients can access more of the care they need, close to home.
- We are a Baby-Friendly® designated hospital, committed to providing exceptional care for mothers and babies, including support for breastfeeding.
- The Presbyterian Española Hospital Board of Trustees, comprised of community members, provided governance, leadership and direction for Presbyterian Española Hospital, clinics and emergency medical services.
