

Presbyterian Santa Fe Medical Center Report to the Community 2022

Presbyterian Santa Fe Medical Center opened in 2018 to offer a new healthcare choice for Santa Fe County and northern New Mexico focused on striving to provide an excellent experience for our patients. Presbyterian Santa Fe Medical Center offers a wide range of healthcare services, including inpatient and emergency care, a family birthing center, and surgical services, as well as primary and specialty care. In addition, we offer community outreach programs including peer support, a teaching kitchen, and a food prescription program for patients in need. Presbyterian Santa Fe Medical Center is part of Presbyterian Healthcare Services, a not-for-profit health system founded in 1908 that includes nine hospitals, a statewide health plan and a multi-specialty medical group.



Our Accomplishments


- As part of our commitment to the health and well-being of the communities we serve, we partner with Santa Fe Farmers' Market to host the Tuesday Del Sur Farmers' Market, which improves access to fresh healthy food and supports local farmers. We also continue to focus on buying food for our cafeteria from local growers and producers, and to furthering our commitment to sustainable purchasing.
- Our Northern Roots produce prescription program provides parents and caregivers with young children 16 weeks of fresh fruits and vegetables, nutrition education and connections to local food resources. More than 106 families participated in 2022.

Serving Our Community in 2022

- We employed 404 people and generated many additional jobs in the community.
- We provided more than \$61.3 million in employee salaries, wages and benefits.
- We provided more than \$35.6 million in community benefit (including financial assistance).
- We invested over \$80,000 in local food infrastructure and food purchasing through the Del Sur Market and produce prescription programs.
- We partner with Presbyterian Community Health to support a new, innovative team of community health workers and peer support specialists to assist patients in connecting to vital community and Presbyterian resources tailored to their needs.
- The Presbyterian Central New Mexico Community Board of Trustees, comprised of community leaders, provided governance, leadership and direction for Santa Fe Medical Center, our clinics and emergency medical services.


Investing in Your Healthcare

- We added several new providers to serve our community, including a
 gastroenterologist, a urologist, a psychologist, two cardiologists, two
 OB/GYNs and five primary care providers.
- We partnered with Nexus Health to expand orthopedic care options for patients at Santa Fe Medical Center. We also began providing robotic surgery options for total knee replacements. The technology collects data before and during surgery to provide additional details about a patient's anatomy for orthopedic surgeons.
