<u>Presbyterian Senior Care (HMO), Presbyterian UltraFlex (HMO-POS),</u> <u>and Presbyterian Dual Plus (HMO D-SNP)</u> <u>Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare</u> <u>to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs</u>

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare.

"Extra Help" Low Income Subsidy (LIS) does not apply to plans already with a \$0 monthly plan premium, such as:

- Presbyterian Senior Care Plan 2 with Rx (HMO)
- Presbyterian UltraFlex (HMO-POS)

It also does not apply to plans without drug coverage, such as:

• Presbyterian Senior Care Plan 1 (HMO)

If you get extra help, your monthly plan premium will be \$0 for any of the plan(s) below. This does not include any Medicare Part B premium you may have to pay.

Presbyterian Dual Plus is an HMO Special Needs Plan (SNP) with a Medicare contract and a contract with the State of New Mexico Human Services Department Medicaid program. Enrollment depends on contract renewal.

Presbyterian Senior Care (HMO) and Presbyterian UltraFlex (HMO-POS) are Medicare Advantage plans with a Medicare contract. Enrollment depends on contract renewal.
