Founded in 1908 as a tuberculosis sanatorium, Presbyterian Healthcare Services has grown into New Mexico's largest locally owned and operated nonprofit healthcare system. It integrates a statewide health plan, a multi-specialty medical group and nine hospitals, providing comprehensive care or health plan coverage to one in three New Mexicans.

WHY PRESBYTERIAN MATTERS

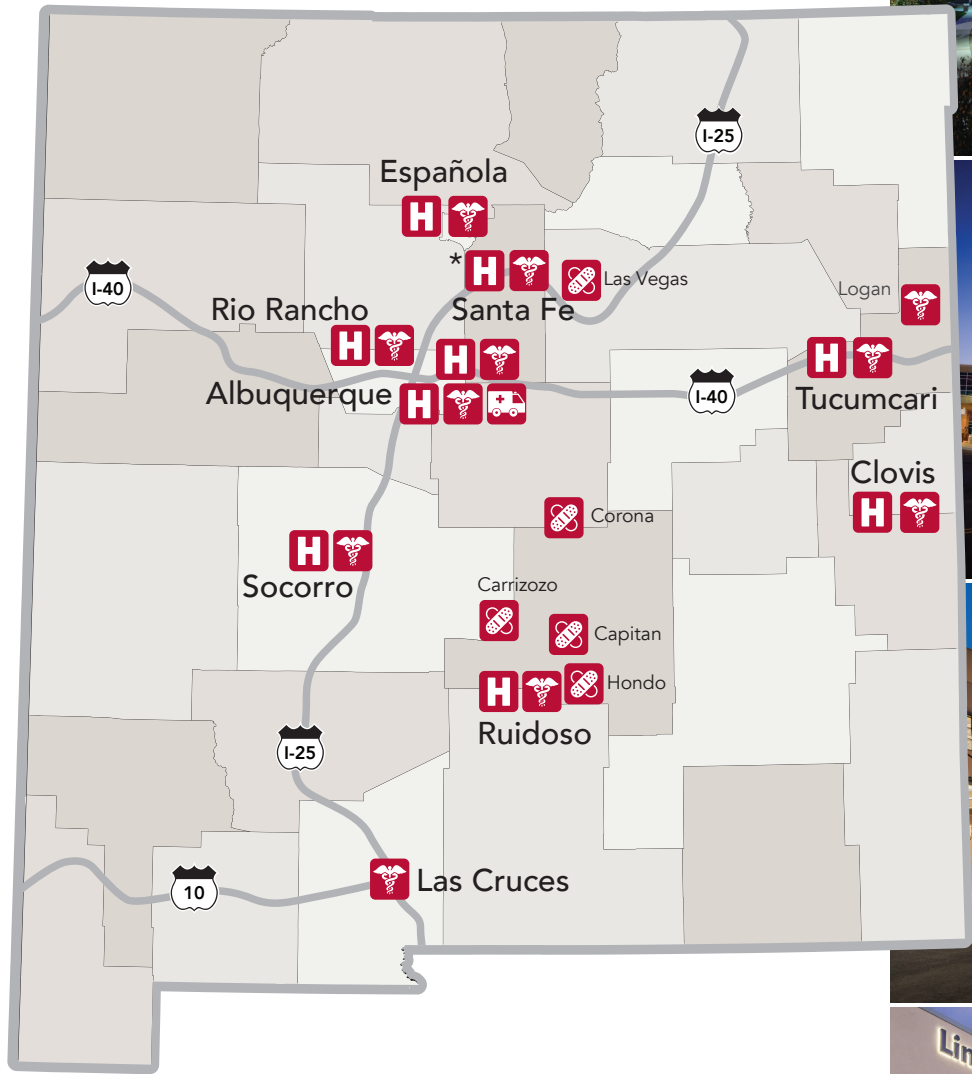
As New Mexico's largest private employer and largest healthcare provider, Presbyterian delivers care and coverage in communities across the state, including many rural and underserved areas.
