A board certified emergency medicine physician, Dr. Medoro has been the medical director of Albuquerque Ambulance Service (AAS) since 2016. AAS is a CAAS-accredited 911 and interfacility emergency medical and transportation service based in Albuquerque, New Mexico, that responds to more than 125,000 calls each year in the Albuquerque metro area.

Prior to joining AAS, Dr. Medoro was medical director of paramedic field instructors and assistant system medical director for the Yale New Haven Sponsor Hospital Program in New Haven, Connecticut. He also was core faculty for Yale University Department of Emergency Medicine's EMS Fellowship and a clinical instructor in Yale's Department of Emergency Medicine.

Dr. Medoro is a former flight paramedic, firefighter, and EMT who spent several years serving New Mexico residents and training local EMS providers. He earned his bachelor's degree in EMS and his medical degree from the University of New Mexico, and completed his residency in emergency medicine at the University of Connecticut School of Medicine. He has made, and continues to contribute to, research in the field of emergency medical services through journal publications and symposia. Dr. Medoro is a member of the National Association of EMS Physicians and the Society of Academic Emergency Medicine.
