

With the help of funding from the Presbyterian Center for Community Health, the Lincoln County Community Health Council published the annual Health & Wellness Guide that acts as a resource directory of Lincoln County health services and wellness programs across the county and Mescalero. In addition to community fitness campaigns that promote prescription trails and fitness infrastructure, the health council has partnered with the Village of Ruidoso to co-sponsor an outdoor weather resistant fitness station, slated for installation in late December.

In addition to providing counseling and crisis services, Lincoln Medical Center promotes positive youth development to help youth build resilience and avoid risky behavior. Additional support includes scholarships and experiential education to help young people pursue health careers, supplies for Freshman tool kits, Maze of Life, and support for the health council partnership with Natural Helpers, a peer support program in schools.

FREE COMMUNITY-WIDE EVENTS

Lincoln County Medical Center hosts a number of free health fairs and community events in Ruidoso, Carrizozo, Corona, and Capitan including free flu shot clinics, and the Annual Run for the Mountain. The health council partners with the medical center and countless other community organizations to bring the whole community together for the annual Stepping Into a Better You Health Fair in Ruidoso.
